- PERT Program for students who are in high school and Adult Services
- Ancillary Services: OT Driving, Occupational Therapy, Assistive Technology, Communication Services

Breakdown of PERT Service Lines Virtual PERT

- Sessions are run on the off week that PERT doesn't have students on campus
- Session are for 2 consecutive days either M/T or W/TH, 2 hours in the morning or afternoon
- Sessions are live and there are several instructors facilitating the session
- Pre-Ets service for students-identify students early in the Transition Process-9th and 10th graders

Virtual PERT Continued

 Virtual Program consists of PowerPoints, videos and interactions with PERT On-Site Counselors and the Residential Team

 Components include: Work Readiness (Work Behaviors, Social Skills, Relationships) Soft Skills/Career Awareness Residential Skills/Independent Living Skills (Money Management, Laundry, Hygiene, Medication, Nutrition) Mindfulness Activities



Service Lines Continued Career Day

- Students participate in two job explorations in positions located throughout the campus
- Teacher chaperones
- Benefits:
 - Students get to know the WWRC environment- a dip your toe in experience!
 - Students get to know staff
 - Try out the food in the cafeteria
- Career Day is a Pre-Ets Activity
- Dates July 20, 2023



Service Lines Continued Career Seminars

- 3 Days and 2 nights Residential Experience
- Students Participate in 2 Job Shadowing Experiences in positions throughout the WWRC Campus
- Workplace Readiness and Social Skills Activities
- Team building activities
- Residential Exploration and Support
- Pre-Ets Activity
- Dates: June 6-8, 2023 and November 28-30, 2023



Service Lines Continued Transition Academy

- 2.5 Day Residential Program
- Teacher/DARS Chaperone
- Program Components:
 - 2 Vocational Exploration areas
 - 2 Independent Experiences
 - Residential and Leisure Activities
- Pre-Ets or VR Service
- Dates: June 20-22, 2023 and December 12-14, 2023



Services Lines Continued PERT Comprehensive Program

- 5-day Residential Program: Monday –Friday at assigned date (annually) with the student's school system
- Program Components:
 - Vocational Exploration
 - Independent Living Skills Exploration
 - Residential and Leisure Skills Experience
- Students attending PERT Comprehensive must be in VR status and it must be listed on Service Plan
- Students with a Disability and Youth with a Disability can participate in this service.

Service Lines Continued Situational Assessments (SITS)

- One week session: Monday –Friday
- Students can be assigned a session during a time year that suits them.
- Eligible students are individuals who received a recommendation in one of WWRC's Training areas.
- Students typically attend prior to the completion of high school
- SITS helps students decide if the Training area is a good fit for them!



Service Lines Continued Work Credential Week

- Sunday-Friday Session in June and November
- Customer Service Credential through the National Retail Federation
- 4 -Day Training in Customer Service
- 1-Day Credential Test
- Residential Activities and Support
- Students are in VR Status
- Dates: March 19-24, 2023; June 25-30 2023; and November 12-17 2023

Work Readiness Program (WRP)

- A program designed to introduce workplace readiness skills to consumers in order to assist consumers with transitioning into employment or further education/training opportunities.
- Consumers will receive differentiated instruction on thirteen (13) workplace readiness skills.
- WRP is a 6-week long Program



Workplace Readiness Skills

- Punctuality/Attendance
- Personal Presentation
- Attention to task/concentration
- Safety Awareness and Practices
- Response to Supervision and Feedback
- Following Instruction
- Initiative and Dependability
- Communication and Interpersonal Skills
- Attention to Detail/Quality Work
- Care with Materials and Property
- Work Energy/Stamina
- Work Tolerance/Persistence
- Meets Work Schedules




Work Readiness Program

- Consumers also can apply these skills in a simulated workplace environment through our pre-employment skills labs. Also, workplace readiness skills will be supported by ancillary staff such as OT, Behavior Health, Communication, Residential Services and Recreational Therapy.
- If there is a need, a student will receive a Vocational Evaluation while attending the Work Readiness Program.
