Computer & IT Occupations are projected to grow much faster than average


In May 2023, the median average wage was \$104,420 vs \$48,060 for all occupations

Solar electric power generation, geothermal electric power generation, and wind electric power generation are projected to be the 3rd fastest growing industry in the economy




Clean / Renewable Energy

Wind Turbine Technicians are the fastest growing U.S. occupation with an estimated 45% growth rate

Solar photovoltaic installers are among the top 20 fastest growing occupations with a 22% growth rate

Youth / CTE Apprenticeship Definitions


- Youth Apprenticeship
 - Apprenticeship programs that serve youth, ages 16-24
 - Combine technical classroom instruction with paid work experience

- CTE Apprenticeship
 - A new proposed apprenticeship for students >16 enrolled in secondary and post-secondary
 - Mandatory coordination with State CTE
 - Delivered through Perkins-eligible programs
