

- observe lesson planning and common assessment creation process with content/grade level team
- observe teacher taught lessons
- act as the teacher applying teaching methods and strategies previously learned
- receive constructive feedback from supporting course teachers





2. CTE Summer Enrichment Camp Internship

- assist teacher in all material and lesson prep during program
- teach at least one lesson during program

1. Cybersecurity

- protects digital information for all students and staff
- identifies security risks
- investigates and documents security breaches
- research emerging cybersecurity threats and trends







2. Desktop Management


- **340,000** computers and mobile computing devices
- "deploying, managing, reporting on, and securing FCPS computers to simplify IT support, maximize resource availability, and increase reliability of client systems"





3. Integrated Digital Technology Services

- event logistics & support
- Teaching Materials Production Center (TMPC)
- production process, including recording & editing video/audio
- multimedia creation; courses, web, podcasting, broadcasting
- User Experience (UX) Design process





4. Network and Systems Services

- maintains school-wide network, Internet connections, cloud services, enterprise wireless network and remote access services
- maintains and supports server infrastructure and centralized storage
- provides data security solutions, conducts security audits; conducts security investigations; ensures compliance with security regulations and government mandates






5. Technology Architecture & Assessment

Assessment of new and emerging technologies for integration into the schools, centers, and administrative offices.

- mobile apps; web applications; enterprise systems; computer hardware and peripherals; platforms/services
- safety and security review; performance testing
- architects on major technology projects to ensure compliance and consistency with the enterprise technology architecture






6. Technology Support Service Center

Technology Support Specialists (TSSpecs)

- on site and front-line support for instructional and administrative computer technologies
- collaborates with school-based technology specialists (SBTS) to ensure consistent quality technology support for schools
- IT representative on district support teams
