Purpose

The job shadowing program is a High- Quality Work-Based Learning experience that provides an opportunity for eligible students to "shadow" an individual for a day at his or her workplace. The experience allows the student to observe the tasks and responsibilities necessary in a particular career cluster, field, or specific job and increase awareness of businesses within the community.



- The Take a 'Peake is a career exploration activity providing an opportunity for eligible Juniors and Seniors to shadow an individual for a day at his or her workplace.
- The 2nd Annual Take a 'Peake Job Shadowing Day event took place February 29, 2024 and culminated CTE Month in Chesapeake.
- 155 students were placed for a Job Shadowing Experience
- 30 Businesses Participated(Damuth Trane, Norfolk Tides, Chesapeake Regional Healthcare, Hatcher & Fey Orthodontics, Pivot Physical Therapy, Checkered Flag, etc)
- 15 Different Departments within the City of Chesapeake (Public Works, 911 Communications Center, City Manager's Office, Commonwealth Attorney's Office, etc.)



Timeline

- Businesses completed a Google Form if they were interested in participating (October/November Timeframe)
 - Participating businesses completed <u>Training Agreement</u>
 - One-pager
- Current Juniors and Seniors were sent email from Communications Department with a link to an <u>Event Fact Sheet</u>
- Flyer was shared via PeachJar
- Work-based Learning Coordinators placed students in positions based upon their application
- Acceptance email to all students (One-Pager, Required Paperwork)
- WBL worked with students to collect all necessary paperwork and to discuss workplace readiness skills (Permission Forms, Training Agreement, etc)
